Mark 14:12-25

¹² On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrifice the Passover lamb, his disciples asked him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare the Passover so that you may eat it?" ¹³ So he sent two of his disciples and told them, "Go into the city, and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him." ¹⁴ Wherever he enters, tell the owner of the house, "The Teacher says, 'Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?'"

¹⁵ He will show you a large room upstairs, furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." ¹⁶ So the disciples went out, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them, and they prepared the Passover. ¹⁷ When evening came, he arrived with the Twelve. ¹⁸ While they were reclining and eating, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me—one who is eating with me."

¹⁹ They began to be distressed and to say to him one by one, "Surely not I?" ²⁰ He said to them, "It is one of the Twelve—the one who is dipping bread in the bowl with me." ²¹ For the Son of Man will go just as it is written about him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been better for him if he had not been born." ²² As they were eating, he took bread, blessed and broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body."





Preparation

1 Corinthians 5:7-8
⁷ Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new unleavened batch, as indeed you are. For Christ our Passover lamb has been sacrificed. ⁸ Therefore, let us observe the feast, not with old leaven or with the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.



The Lord's Supper
Representation
1 Corinthians 11:23-25
23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took bread, ²⁴and when he had given thanks, broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, and said, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."




