



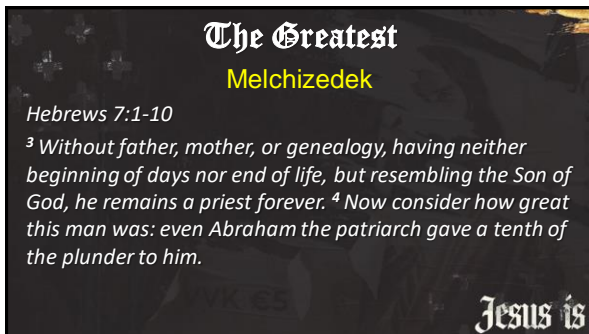
## The Greatest

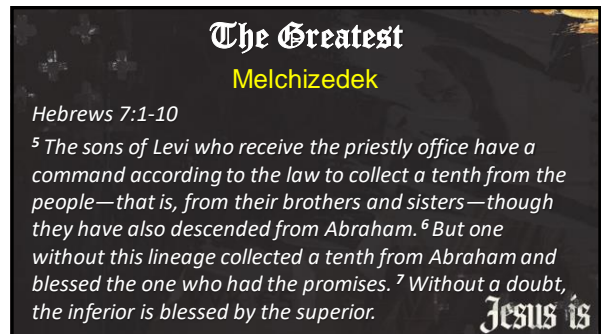

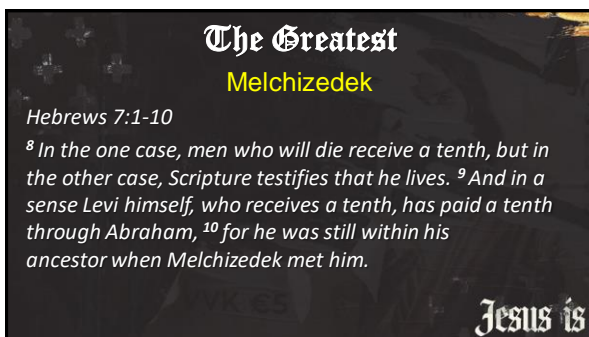

<sup>5</sup> The sons of Levi who receive the priestly office have a command according to the law to collect a tenth from the people—that is, from their brothers and sisters—though they have also descended from Abraham. <sup>6</sup> But one without this lineage collected a tenth from Abraham and blessed the one who had the promises. <sup>7</sup> Without a doubt, the inferior is blessed by the superior.

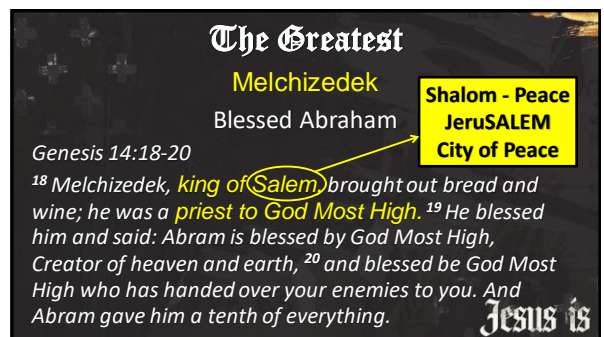
