Genesis 4:3-5

<sup>3</sup> In the course of time Cain presented some of the land's produce as an offering to the LORD. <sup>4</sup> And Abel also presented an offering—some of the firstborn of his flock and their fat portions. The LORD had regard for Abel and his offering, <sup>5</sup> but he did not have regard for Cain and his offering. Cain was furious, and he looked despondent.

**Salvation** is based upon God's pardon.



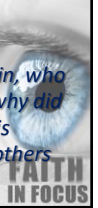

And why did he murder him? Because his deeds were evil, and his brother's were righteous. <sup>13</sup> Do not be surprised, brothers and sisters, if the world hates you.

Genesis 5:21-24

<sup>21</sup> Enoch was 65 years old when he fathered Methuselah. <sup>22</sup> **And after he fathered Methuselah, Enoch walked with God 300 years and fathered other sons and daughters.** <sup>23</sup> So Enoch's life lasted 365 years. <sup>24</sup> **Enoch walked with God; then he was not there because God took him.**
