Matthew 2:1-12 ¹After Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of King Herod, <u>wise</u> <u>men from the east</u> arrived in Jerusalem,² saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw <u>his star</u> at its rising and have come to <u>worship him</u>,²¹ When King Herod heard this, he was deeply disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him.⁴ So he assembled all the chief priests and scribes of the people and asked them where the Messiah would be born.⁵ "In Bethlehem of Judea," they told him, "because this is what was written by the prophet: ⁶ And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah: Because out of you will come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel." 7 Then Herod secretly summoned the wise men and asked them the exact time the star appeared.⁸ He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search carefully for the child. ⁹ After hearing the king, they went on their way. And there it was—the star they had seen at its rising. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts: <u>aold, frankincense, and myrrh</u>. ¹² And being warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their own country by another route
