1 Chronicles 16:7-36

7 On that day David decreed for the first time that thanks be given to the Lord by Asaph and his relatives: 8 Give thanks to the Lord; call on his name; proclaim his deeds among the peoples. 9 Sing to him; sing praise to him; tell about all his wondrous works! 10 Honor his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice.

SING PRAISE!

11 Seek the Lord and his strength; seek his face always. 12 Remember the wondrous works he has done, his wonders, and the judgments he has pronounced, 13 you offspring of Israel his servant, Jacob's descendants—his chosen ones. 14 He is the Lord our God; his judgments govern the whole earth. 15 Remember his covenant forever—the promise he ordained for a thousand generations, 16 the covenant he made with Abraham, swore to Isaac,

SING PRAISE!

17 and confirmed to Jacob as a decree, and to Israel as a permanent covenant: 18 "I will give the land of Canaan to you as your inherited portion." 19 When they were few in number, very few indeed, and resident aliens in Canaan 20 wandering from nation to nation and from one kingdom to another, 21 he allowed no one to oppress them; he rebuked kings on their behalf: 22 "Do not touch my anointed ones or harm my prophets."

23 Let the whole earth sing to the Lord. Proclaim his salvation from day to day. 24 Declare his glory among the nations, his wondrous works among all peoples. 25 For the Lord is great and highly praised; he is feared above all gods. 26 For all the gods of the peoples are idols, but the Lord made the heavens. 27 Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his place. 28 Ascribe to the Lord, families of the peoples, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.

29 Ascribe to the Lord the glory of his name; bring an offering and come before him. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness; 30 let the whole earth tremble before him. The world is firmly established; it cannot be shaken. 31 Let the heavens be glad and the earth rejoice, and let them say among the nations, "The Lord reigns!" 32 Let the sea and all that fills it resound; let the fields and everything in them exult.

Then all the people said, "Amen" and "Praise the Lord."

*23 Let the whole earth sing to the Lord. **Proclaim his salvation** from day to day. 24 **Declare his glory** among the nations, **his wondrous works** among all peoples.*

Components of Worship:

Proclamation: (God's Word is preeminently proclaimed)

While songs can and should proclaim God's Word, music should never take the place of God's Word being expounded upon and taught as a part of congregational worship.

Revelation: (God reveals Himself) (Isaiah 6)

*1 In the year that King Uzziah died, **I saw the Lord seated on a high and lofty throne, and the hem of his robe filled the temple.** 2 Seraphim[a] were standing above him; they each had six wings: with two they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. 3 And one called to another: Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Armies; his glory fills the whole earth.*

1 Chron. 16:29 Ascribe to the Lord the glory of his name; bring an offering and come before him. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness;

Romans 12:1 Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship.

Dedication: Continual Response In Worship

Psalm 96 Sing a new song to the Lord; let the whole earth sing to the Lord. Sing to the Lord, bless his name; proclaim his salvation from day to day. Declare his glory among the nations, his wondrous works among all peoples

Exodus 15:1 Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the Lord. They said: I will sing to the Lord, for he is highly exalted; he has thrown the horse and its rider into the sea.

Numbers 21:17 Then Israel sang this song: Spring up, well—sing to it!

Deuteronomy 31:19
Therefore write down this song for yourselves and teach it to the Israelites; have them sing it, so that this song may be a witness for me against the Israelites.

2 Samuel 22:50

SING PRAISE!Is Singing Praise Optional?

2 Chronicles 29:28

The whole assembly was worshiping, singing the song, and blowing the trumpets—all this continued until the burnt offering was completed.

2 Chronicles 29:30

Then King Hezekiah and the officials told the Levites to sing praise to the Lord in the words of David and of the seer Asaph. So they sang praises with rejoicing and knelt low and worshiped.

Isaiah 12:5

Sing to the Lord, for he has done glorious things. Let this be known throughout the earth.

Colossians 3:16
Let the word of Christ dwell richly among you, in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another through psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray. Is anyone cheerful? He should sing praises.

What You Miss By Not Singing

1. You miss out on being obedient to God's Word
(Connecting With Jesus)

As these passages have pointed out, God expects us to sing praise to Him. When we don't we are not being obedient.

What You Miss By Not Singing

2. You miss the opportunity to experience true worship.
(Connecting With Jesus)

True worship requires obedience.
 You cannot experience genuine worship if you are ignoring one of the most basic commands in worship.

Yes, we can and we should have a song in our hearts, but it is clear that God intends for us to express it verbally.


SING PRAISE!
