


Jesus Is More Than a Man

### 1 Corinthians 15:13-18

<sup>13</sup> If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised; <sup>14</sup> and if Christ has not been raised, then our proclamation is in vain, and so is your faith. <sup>15</sup> Moreover, we are found to be false witnesses about God, because we have testified wrongly about God that he raised up Christ—whom he did not raise up, if in fact the dead are not raised. <sup>16</sup> For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised. <sup>17</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. <sup>18</sup> Those, then, who have falen asleep in Christ have also perished.
