Christianity- the <u>city</u>.

Denominations- the <u>neighborhoods</u>.

Churches- the houses.

THE AGE OF JESUS & THE APOSTLES

Matthew 28:18-20 The Great Commission, The nations of Pentecost, Acts 1:8 What is an apostle?

- The word "apostle" literally means "sent one"
- apostles were eye witnesses to the resurrected Jesus which led to more trust and authority
- apostle's <u>names</u> are recorded in the New Testament
- after Acts 1 there is no record of apostles being replaced
- Paul was an <u>unusual</u> apostle (1 Corinthians 15:8)

PERSECUTION OF THE EARLY CHURCH

Jewish Persecution

- Jesus and his original disciples were <u>Jewish</u>
- The New Testament is filled with conflict between Judaism and those who follow Jesus
- <u>Stephen</u> was the first martyr (Acts 7)

Roman Persecution

- Rome hated the Jews and the Jews hated Rome
- Rome was its own state religion with <u>Caesar</u> as their god
- The Coliseum
- Death of the apostles

THE AGE OF CATHOLIC CHRISTIANITY: AD 70 – 312

- Catholic means <u>universal</u>. This term was used many years before the Roman Catholic Church formed.
- The church had spread to many different regions over <u>3</u> continents
- Councils & Creeds; The Apostle's Creed
- · Heresy is widespread
 - o Gnostics hidden knowledge
 - Marcion vengeful God of the OT v/s gentle Jesus of NT
 - Sabellius modalism... God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit are not distinct persons
 - Arius Jesus is a lesser god Bishop Nicholas (St. Nicholas) slapped Arius at the Council of Nicea

TROUBLE IN ROME

- The Roman Empire lasted 422 years (the USA turns 247 in 2023)
 Some reasons for Rome's fall-political instability, economic & social problems, inability to protect their vast domain from outsiders
- In 313 AD Emperor Constantine professes Christianity
