



JOHN WYCLIF, THE OG PROTESTANT WEEK 3 "Christ refused temporal dominion, the Pope seeks it." - John Wyclif · Wyclif challenged medieval Roman Catholic beliefs: pardons, indulgences, absolutions, pilgrimages, the worship of images, adoration of saints, etc... Wyclif & friends translated the scriptures into the language of common people 43 years after his death, Roman Catholic officials dug up his body, burned his remains, and threw the ashes into the river




