THE CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH & THE NEW WORLD
 John Robinson fled England in 1609 because of religious persecution to settle in the Netherlands. He was influenced by Christians there from the Swiss Reformation & formed what is known as the Congregational Church.
 In 1620 Robinson's congregation boarded The Mayflower (with Puritans & others), earning the name "Pilgrims", & headed toward Massachusetts Bay. There they established a "theocratic" government based on Biblical law and Calvin's theology.
 The Congregational Church was a big influence on Colonial America...1st Great Awakening...

THE FIRST AMERICAN DENOMINATION

Many Separatists from the Anglican Church (Puritans & others) fled religious persecution by coming to the New World.

In 1631 Separatist minister Roger Williams came to the Colonies. He was a strong advocate of freedom of faith & conscience. After being run out of the Massachusetts Bay he founded the town of Providence, Rhode Island, where he established The First Baptist Meetinghouse in 1638.

Baptists grew greatly in the 1st Great Awakening & eventually exported to England.




