



Jesus in Abraham's Journey Abraham's Salvation Experience Abraham Responded by Faith 4 So Abram went, as the LORD had told him, and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he left Haran. FHE took his wife, Sarai, his nephew Lot, all the possessions they had accumulated, and the people they had acquired in Haran, and they set out for the land of Canaan. When they came to the land of Canaan, 6 Abram passed through the land to the site of Shechem, at the oak of Moreh. (At that time the Canaanites were in the land.) 7 The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built an altar there to the LORD who had appeared to him. From there he moved on to the hill country east of Bethel and oliched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on country east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with **Bethel** on the west and Ai on the east. <u>He built an altar to the LORD</u> there, and he called on the name of the LORD.

Genesis 13:5-13

⁵Now Lot, who was traveling with Abram, also had flocks, herds, and tents. ⁶ But the land was unable to support them as long as they stayed together, for they had so many possessions that they could not stay together, ⁷ and there was quarreling between the herdsmen of Abram's livestock and the herdsmen of Lot's livestock. (At that time the Canaanites and the Perizzites were living in the land.) ⁸ So Abram said to Lot, "Please, let's not have quarreling between you and me, or between your herdsmen and my herdsmen, since we are relatives. ⁹Isn't the whole land before you? Separate from me: If you go to the left, I will go to the right; If you go to the right, I will go to the left."
