

### Jesus in the Encounter between Moses and Pharaoh

**GOD'S COMMAND**

*Exodus 5:1-9*

<sup>1</sup> Later, Moses and Aaron went in and said to Pharaoh, **"This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: Let my people go,** so that they may hold a festival for me in the wilderness."<sup>2</sup> But Pharaoh responded, "Who is the LORD that I should obey him by letting Israel go? I don't know the LORD, and besides, I will not let Israel go."<sup>3</sup> They answered, "The God of the Hebrews has met with us. Please let us go on a three-day trip into the wilderness so that we may sacrifice to the LORD our God, or else he may strike us with plague or sword."<sup>4</sup> The king of Egypt said to them, "Moses and Aaron, why are you causing the people to neglect their work? Get to your labor!"

### Jesus in the Encounter between Moses and Pharaoh

**GOD'S COMMAND**

*Exodus 5:1-9*

<sup>5</sup> Pharaoh also said, "Look, the people of the land are so numerous, and you would stop them from their labor."<sup>6</sup> That day Pharaoh commanded the overseers of the people as well as their foremen,<sup>7</sup> "Don't continue to supply the people with straw for making bricks, as before. They must go and gather straw for themselves."<sup>8</sup> But require the same quota of bricks from them as they were making before; do not reduce it. For they are slackers—that is why they are crying out, 'Let us go and sacrifice to our God.'<sup>9</sup> Impose heavier work on the men. Then they will be occupied with it and not pay attention to deceptive words."

**THE PLAGUES**

**#1 Water Changed to Blood**

*Exodus 7:19-21*

<sup>19</sup> So the LORD said to Moses, "Tell Aaron: Take your staff and stretch out your hand over the waters of Egypt—over **their rivers, canals, ponds, and all their water reservoirs—and they will become blood.** There will be blood throughout the land of Egypt, even in wooden and stone containers."<sup>20</sup> Moses and Aaron did just as the LORD had commanded; in the sight of Pharaoh and his officials, he raised the staff and struck the water in the Nile, and all the water in the Nile was turned to blood.<sup>21</sup> The fish in the Nile died, and the river smelled so bad the Egyptians could not drink water from it. **There was blood throughout the land of Egypt.**

Exodus 9:5-7

*<sup>5</sup> And the LORD set a time, saying, "Tomorrow the LORD will do this thing in the land." <sup>6</sup> The LORD did this the next day. All the Egyptian livestock died, but none among the Israelite livestock died. <sup>7</sup> Pharaoh sent messengers who saw that not a single one of the Israelite livestock was dead. But Pharaoh's heart was hard, and he did not let the people go.*

**#6 People With Boils on the Body**

Exodus 9:10-11

*<sup>10</sup> So they took furnace soot and stood before Pharaoh. Moses threw it toward heaven, and it became festering boils on people and animals. <sup>11</sup> The magicians could not stand before Moses because of the boils, for the boils were on the magicians as well as on all the Egyptians.*

*<sup>21</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand toward heaven, and there will be darkness over the land of Egypt, a darkness that can be felt." <sup>22</sup> So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was thick darkness throughout the land of Egypt for three days. <sup>23</sup> One person could not see another, and for three days they did not move from where they were. Yet all the Israelites had light where they lived.*

*Exodus 10:9 & 11*  
<sup>9</sup> *Moses replied, "We will go with our young and with our old; we will go with our sons and with our daughters, with our flocks and with our herds because we must hold the LORD's festival."*  
<sup>11</sup> *No, go—just able-bodied men—worship the LORD, since that's what you want." And they were driven from Pharaoh's presence.*

We will not know what we will use to worship the LORD until we get there."*
