¹Later, Moses and Aaron went in and said to Pharaoh, "This is what the Loro, the God of Israel, says: Let my people go, so that they may hold a festival for me in the wilderness." ²But Pharaoh responded, "Who is the Loro that I should obey him by letting Israel go? I don't know the Loro, and besides, I will not let Israel go." ³ They answered, "The God of the Hebrews has met with us. Please let us go on a three-day trip into the wilderness so that we may sacrifice to the Loro our God, or else he may strike us with plague or sword." ⁴ The king of Egypt said to them, "Moses and Aaron, why are you causing the people to neglect their work? Get to your labor!"






⁵ Pharaoh also said, "Look, the people of the land are so numerous, and you would stop them from their labor."

⁶ That day Pharaoh commanded the overseers of the people as well as their foremen, ⁷ "Don't continue to supply the people with straw for making bricks, as before. They must go and gather straw for themselves. ⁸ But require the same quota of bricks from them as they were making before; do not reduce it. For they are slackers—that is why they are crying out, 'Let us go and sacrifice to our God.' ⁹ Impose heavier work on the men. Then they will be occupied with it and not pay attention to deceptive words."








⁹ Moses replied, "We will go with our young and with our old; we will go with our sons and with our daughters, with our flocks and with our herds because we must hold the LORD's festival."


¹¹ No, go—just able-bodied men—worship the LORD, since that's what you want." And they were driven from Pharaoh's presence.
