PHARAOH'S REFUSAL

Exodus 11:1-10

¹ The LORD said to Moses, "I will bring one more plague on Pharaoh and on Egypt. After that, he will let you go from here. When he lets you go, he will drive you out of here." ² Now announce to the people that both men and women should ask their neighbors for silver and gold items." ³ The LORD gave the people favor with the Egyptians. In addition, Moses himself was very highly regarded in the land of Egypt by Pharaoh's officials and the people.

PHARAOH'S REFUSAL

Exodus 11:1-10

⁴ So Moses said, "This is what the LORD says: About midnight I will go throughout Egypt, ⁵ and every firstborn male in the land of Egypt will die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh who sits on his throne to the firstborn of the servant girl who is at the grindstones, as well as every firstborn of the livestock." ⁶ Then there will be a great cry of anguish through all the land of Egypt such as never was before or ever will be again. ⁷ But against all the Israelites, whether people or animals, not even a dog will snarl, so that you may know that the LORD makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel. ⁸ All these officials of yours will come down to me and bow before me, saying: Get out, you and all the people who follow you. After that, I will get out." And he went out from Pharaoh's presence fiercely angry.

PHARAOH'S REFUSAL

Exodus 11:1-10

⁹ The LORD said to Moses, "Pharaoh will not listen to you, so that my wonders may be multiplied in the land of Egypt." ¹⁰ Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh, but the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, and he would not let the Israelites go out of his land.

THE SPECIFIC DETAILS

Exodus 12:5-13

⁵ You must have an unblemished animal, a year-old male; you may take it from either the sheep or the goats. ⁶ You are to keep it until the fourteenth day of this month; then the whole assembly of the community of Israel will slaughter the animals at twilight. ⁷ They must take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses where they eat them. ⁸ They are to eat the meat that night; they should eat it, roasted over the fire along with unleavened bread and bitter herbs. ⁹ Do not eat any of it raw or cooked in boiling water, but only roasted over fire—its head as well as its legs and inner organs. ¹⁰ You must not leave any of it until morning; any part of it left until morning you must burn.

THE SPECIFIC DETAILS

Exodus 12:5-13

¹¹ Here is how you must eat it: You must be dressed for travel, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. You are to eat it in a hurry; it is the LORD's Passover.

¹² "I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night and strike every firstborn male in the land of Egypt, both people and animals. I am the LORD; I will execute judgments against all the gods of Egypt. ¹³ The blood on the houses where you are staying will be a distinguishing mark for you; when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No plague will be among you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

Slaughter at Twilight

Exodus 12:6 You are to keep it until the fourteenth day of this month; then the whole assembly of the community of Israel will slaughter the animals at twilight.

The Blood Must Be Applied

Exodus 12:7 They must take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses where they eat them.

THE SPECIFIC DETAILS

Must Be Eaten With Anticipation

Exodus 12:11 Here is how you must eat it: You must be dressed for travel, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. You are to eat it in a hurry; it is the LORD's Passover.

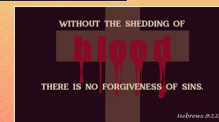


When You Receive the Lamb of God by Faith; You Must Receive Him With Anticipation, Because at That Moment You Are Set Free From Bondage

THE SPECIFIC DETAILS



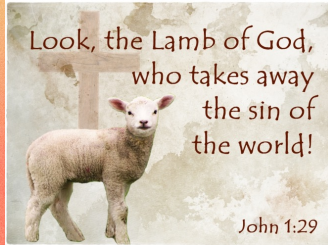
Exodus 11-12 Provides a Powerful Foreshadowing of the Lord Jesus, Showing Him As:

- The Spotless Lamb Whose Blood Saves
- The One Who Delivers From Slavery
- The Firstborn Son Who Dies So That Others Can Have Life
- This Event in Exodus Is a Direct Precursor to the Sacrifice of Jesus

THE RESPONSE

Exodus 12:21-24

²¹ Then Moses summoned all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go, select an animal from the flock according to your families, and slaughter the Passover animal. ²² Take a cluster of hyssop, dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and brush the lintel and the two doorposts with some of the blood in the basin. None of you may go out the door of his house until morning. ²³ When the LORD passes through to strike Egypt and sees the blood on the lintel and the two doorposts, he will pass over the door and not let the destroyer enter your houses to strike you. ²⁴ "Keep this command permanently as a statute for you and your descendants."
